Professor Dr Kei Yamada

Dr. Yamada was born in Osaka, Japan, on 1963. He received his M.D. degree from Kyoto Prefectural University of Medicine (KPUM), Japan, in 1989. After his residency training in Japan, he moved to USA for fellowship at several institutions, including University of Maryland, University of Rochester and Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH). During his total of 4 years of training in USA, he published multiple papers, most of which are MRI related, and received Winthrop fellow of the year in 1996. He came back to KPUM, Japan and became a faculty member of the university in 1999. He continued on his research in the field of perfusion weighted imaging and DTI/tractography.
